To Whom It May Concern:

Enclosed you will find a copy of a Millage Levy Resolution and L-4029s adopted by the Board of Trustees of the Grand Rapids Community College on June 12, 2023 concerning its determination to impose a summer property tax levy of 100% of its property taxes for 2023/24 fiscal year.

As before, we would like you to collect our summer property taxes for us. If you were previously part of our agreement whereby the KISD is billed directly for GRCC's portion of summer tax collection fees, we would expect this arrangement to continue unless otherwise notified.

We appreciate the service you have given us. If you represent a taxing unit only collecting for summer or winter, we assume this practice would continue unless otherwise advised. Both L4029s have been included in mailings to all of our taxing units but please disregard one if you tax in summer or winter only. The following Resolution was offered by member Brvinsma
and supported by member Williams.

MILLAGE LEVY RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, the school electors of the Grand Rapids Community College have authorized a maximum annual tax rate in the amount of 1.9 mills for general operating purposes; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees in accordance with budgetary requirements finds that it is necessary to levy the full millage rate it is authorized by law to levy and that the Board of Trustees has additionally carefully examined the financial circumstances of the Community College district for the 2023-2024 fiscal year including estimated expenditures, estimated revenues, projected state aid, and taxable value of the property located within the district; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees has complete authority to establish a maximum of 1.9 mills to be levied for operating purposes for the 2023-2024 fiscal year from within its maximum authorized millage rate, subject to whatever rollback may be required by the Headlee Amendment and its implementing legislation; and

WHEREAS, the Headlee Amendment and its implementing legislation requires the financial officer of the community college each year to make certain computations regarding the tax rate using data supplied by the Kent County Equalization Director, the Kent County Treasurer and the State Tax Commission; and

WHEREAS, the Headlee computation process for the 2023-2024 fiscal year requires a millage rollback of the authorized millage from 1.9 mills to 1.7085 mills;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE GRAND RAPIDS COMMUNITY COLLEGE AS FOLLOWS:

- (1) That there be levied upon the taxable value of property within the Grand Rapids Community College district as appears from the tax rolls of the cities and townships in the Community College district, 1.7085 mills for operating purposes for the 2023-2024 fiscal year.
- (2) That the Secretary of the Board of Trustees be and is hereby authorized and directed to deliver and file forthwith with the Clerk of each city and township in the Community College district this Resolution and that there upon the proper officials of said cities and townships are hereby directed to levy the above mentioned taxes on the taxable property within the Grand Rapids Community College district upon the 2024 assessment roll.


(3) That all resolutions and parts of resolutions insofar as they conflict with the provisions hereof, be and the same are hereby rescinded.
