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

For property in the Greenville Public and Tri County Area Schools a separate L-4029 is enclosed:

- Allocated 0.1699
- Special Ed. Operating 3.4145
- Total 3.5844

Also enclosed is a copy of the Statutory Tax Collection Distribution Dates for the 2023-2024 tax collection year. As you know, Section 43(3)(a) of Michigan's General Property Tax Act [MCL 211.43(3)(a)] requires that tax collecting units distribute tax collections on hand within ten business days after the first and fifteenth day of each month. Montcalm ISD requests that disbursements of tax collections be made in strict compliance with the Statutory Tax Collection Distribution Dates and the General Property Tax Act. Montcalm Area ISD would consider waiving its right to any interest payment as long as such tax payments are made in compliance with the Statutory Tax Collection Distribution Dates.
