Nutritional Services

Community Meals

- Senior lunch for those 60 and over.
- A space to meet new people and have good conversation.
- Lunch daily in White Cloud. Meal starter is served at 11:30am, lunch served at 12:00pm.

Home Delivered Meals

- Warm meals delivered to homebound people Monday thru Friday.
- Must meet the eligibility requirements.

In Home and Respite Services

Homemaker

Homemakers are available for basic housekeeping, laundry, and the occasional errand. Priority is given to those with the greatest needs.

White Pine Adult Day Group

The White Pine Adult Day Group is designed to relieve some of the physical and emotional stress of the caregiving responsibilities for those whose loved one is living with cognitive disabilities, Alzheimer's and other forms of dementia. Our Adult Day Services provide opportunities for socialization, recreation, and activities to increase mental skills. Some transportation and a noon meal are provided.

Specialized Respite

Specialized Respite services are offered to assist caregivers. Assistance is provided by a local home care agency.

Information to have ready

- Passenger's name, phone number and home address.
- Date and address of drop off location.
- Time to be picked up, time that you need to arrive by, and return time.
- If you will be accompanied by a Personal Care Attendant.
- Any mobility restrictions to take into consideration.
