PROCESS

Samaritan's Purse is currently assembling teams of volunteers to help homeowners in your area with cleanup. Here is how our assessment and selection process works:

- Step 1: You, the homeowner, submit a request for help.
- Step 2: Our assessors will be in touch by phone to schedule a needs assessment.
- Step 3: A Samaritan's Purse Team Leader will follow up to complete any work within our capacity.
- Step 4: Volunteer teams will arrive, easily recognized by our vehicles and by the orange Samaritan's Purse T-shirts.

- Our team member may call from a phone number outside of this area but will identify himself/herself as representing Samaritan's Purse.
- We cannot give an exact time frame for completion of work, as many variables affect our timelines.
