

## Newaygo County Soil Erosion Permit Fee Schedule

<b>Residential Project/Conversion to Cropland</b> Over 1024 Sq. Ft. (i.e. 32'x32')	<b>\$100.00</b>	
<b>Minor Residential Project/Seawall/Farm Tile</b> 225 - 1024 Sq. Ft.	<b>\$50.00</b>	
<b>Waiver</b> 10 -225 Sq. Ft. (Nothing required for 10 Sq. Ft. or less)	<b>\$10.00</b> <b>\$20.00</b>	Residential Commercial
<b>Land Development/Commercial</b> (Subdivisions, Industrial, Recreational, etc.)	<b>\$300.00</b> <b>\$125.00</b>	<u>Up to</u> 1 acre Each additional acre or fraction thereof
<b>Engineering Review Deposit</b>	<b>\$1,000.00</b>	Add in additional expenses (engineering)
<b>Surface Mining</b> (Gravel, Sand, Clay, Stone, etc.)	<b>\$325.00</b> <b>\$650.00</b>	<u>Up to</u> 2,500 yards hauled out <u>Over</u> 2,500 yards hauled out
<b>Utilities</b> (Roads, Railroads, Phone line, Electric line, etc.)	<b>\$300.00</b> <b>\$125.00</b>	<u>Up to</u> 1 mile Each additional mile or fraction thereof
<b>Drainage Ditches</b>	<b>\$100.00</b> <b>\$50.00</b>	<u>Up to</u> 1 mile Each additional fraction thereof
<b>Ponds</b>	<b>\$200.00</b> <b>\$75.00</b>	<u>Up to</u> 1 acre Each additional acre or fraction thereof

**Notes:**

Those working without a permit will be charged double the permit fee.

Normal tiling, planting, and harvesting of crops are exempt.

Farmers working under agreement with the Soil Conservation Service are exempt provided they comply with the regulations of Part 91 of Act 451 of 1994, as amended.

Logging is exempt, however access roads or other activities associated with logging may require a permit.

Cash, check and money order are accepted in the office. Credit/Debit cards are accepted with an additional processing fee. Make checks payable to Newaygo County.

Permits expire 1 year from issue date.
