DEPARTMENT UPDATE Joann Hunt, Equalization Director

Equalization updates included:

- Assessment notices for real property were mailed out February 12<sup>th</sup> for the City of Fremont and February 19<sup>th</sup> for all other cities and townships we provide service.
- The virtual organizational meeting for the City of Fremont took place February 23<sup>rd</sup>. The City of Grant's organizational meeting is March 2<sup>nd</sup>.
- Staff have been preparing for the Equalization process and setting up 2021 reports for analysis.

- Assisted NCRESA and fiber company opening manhole covers for pictures of conduit for upcoming project.
- Picked up new County logo decals from Power Graphics and applied to the fleet.
- Continued with snow removal of parking lots and sidewalks.

#### DEPARTMENT UPDATE Nick Smith, Parks Director

#### Parks updates included:

- **Sales** Reservations have been substantial and set new records. January credit card sales saw an increase by 45% compared to 2020.
- Dragon Construction Task order 3 is currently out to bid. Spicer Group LLC is working with Mecosta Township to oversee their DNR Grant Build and working with Mecosta County to manage construction this season.
- Disc Golf Update All construction in the forested areas is on hold until the Forestry Plan is completed this year. In the meantime, planning to move forward with the install of 7 holes this season.

#### GIS updates included:

- Responded to various internal requests for maps, data, and technical assistance from Drains, Parks, ROD, and Equalization.
